# 2017-2018 Overview

- Goals
  - Registered Girl Goal: 1,137 girls
    - As of 12/02 we are at 987 girls (86.8%)
  - Registered Adult Goal: 619 adults
    - As of 11/17 we are at 497 adults (80.3%)
  - Fall Product Goal: \$97,757.82
    - Our total: \$100,711.25 (adjusted from last report)
  - Cookie Program Goal: 11,053 cases
  - Family Partnership Goal: \$500
