February in Cookies

- February 5th (yesterday): Transaction tab opens for cupboard orders
- February 11th: Cookie pick up
- February 12th: Cookie Cupboards open
- February 16th: Cookie booths begin
- February 27th: ACH adjustment form due
- March 1st: ACH #1 – 50% of what is due to council from your initial order

Cookie Booths

- Etiquette
 - Identifiable – girls should be uniform and dressed appropriately for the weather. You can send home girls who arrive improperly dressed.
 - SUPERVISION
 - Registered Adults – all adults who stay for the booth should be registered for two reason: 1) insurance and 2) background check
 - Girl/Adult Ratio – no more than 3 girls at each door, please. You can have runners, but more than 3 is a recipe for disaster and a supervision nightmare.
 - Booth set up, signs, decorations
 - Have fun! Take pictures! Double check your spelling!
 - Money handling
 - Only adults for younger levels
 - Do not keep money out in the open
 - Start and Stop Time
 - Respect the troop who is there. Do not set up prior to your time. Have a case of cookie with multiple varieties and one girl who works the crowd while you are setting up.
 - Respect the troop who is coming in. If your booth ends at 11, you need to be gone at 11.
 - eBudde
 - Reserving and releasing – if you cannot make your booth, please release it (same way you selected it)

Cookie Cupboards

- Council Cupboard
 - Council Locations
 - Lisle @ U-Stor
 - All 8 varieties
 - Cupboard orders
 - In eBudde
 - Full Cases only
 - Pay in the 2nd ACH
 - Will NOT receive confirmation – come at selected date/time
 - Goal Getter
- Volunteer Cupboard
 - Volunteer locations
 - All 8 Varieties
 - Cupboard orders only
 - In eBudde
 - Full Cases only
 - Pay in the 2nd ACH
 - WILL receive confirmation of selected date/time

Goal Getters

- A way to get extra cookies
 - Troop leaders OR Parents can pick up
 - At council locations only
 - Pre-pay only
 - Walk-in only
 - DO NOT do anything in eBudde
 - Council enters troop transaction and payment
 - Council enters girl transaction and payment

Goal Getters vs Cupboard

- Goal Getters
 - Troop Volunteers/Parents
 - ONLY council locations
 - NO eBudde by troop
 - Individual Packages
 - PAY at time of purchase
 - Walk-in only
 - Council uploads
- Cupboard
 - Troop Volunteers only
 - Council & Volunteer
 - eBudde order required
 - FULL CASES only
 - PAY in 2nd ACH
 - Appointment required
 - Council location request date/time in eBudde transaction and show up at requested time.
 - Volunteer location requested date/time and get confirmation from cupboard.
