2017-2018 Overview

- Goals
 - Registered Girl Goal: 1,137 girls
 - As of 3/6 we are at 1,039 girls (91.4%)
 - Registered Adult Goal: 619 adults
 - As of 11/17 we are at 552 adults (89.2%)
 - Fall Product Goal: \$97,757.82

 - Cookie Program Goal: 11,053 cases
 - Current total 125,008 pkgs/10,417 cases (94.2%)
